CULTURAL LEARNING

Interactive learning experiences to understand the cultural roots of Bali and their daily life. Activities vary from history, religion and ritual, flora and fauna to architecture and art of living in Bali, a contemporary understanding of today's culture.

Arts and Fabrics 5 hours USD 65.00

Our Leisure Concierge will guide you to the most famous site in Klungkung; Kertha Gosa, the courthouse of the old kingdom. The dreadful punishments said to be reserved for sinners in another life are illustrated on the roof of the courthouse. You will visit The Gunarsa Museum of Classical and Modern Art which features many elements of Balinese Artistic and cultural heritage. After this visit, our Leisure Concierge will bring you to "The Kamasan Style School of Traditional Painting" to see the materials and procedures used to create traditional paintings. After lunch, meet Bapak Dewa Alit and learn the weaving and dying process of the Sidemen village sarongs, famous for its unique design and color. This tour ends with a visit to a traditional Silver Smith at Budakeling. The Balinese silversmiths are known worldwide for their intricate designs and meticulous attention to detail.

Goa Lawah & Sea Salt Making 3 hours USD 30.00

Enjoy visiting the famous Goa Lawah (Batcave) located 15 km southwest of Alila Manggis. The cave itself is home to thousand of bats and the temple was built in front of the entrance. The combination of squeaking bats, crowds of kneeling devotees with colorful offerings, burning incense and priests' prayers, makes this visit to Goa Lawah during ceremony a fascinating experience. On the way back to the hotel, we stop at Kusamba which is famous for making organic sea salt. Here you will see the process of carrying sea water and sprinkling it over the black sand until concentrated sea salt. A Short but impressive trip to have a glimpse of East Bali.

The East of Bali 5 hours USD 50.00

A journey to discover East of Bali. Be surprised by the beauty of the East, its local people and villages, which you will pass along the way. Firstly, our Leisure Concierge brings you to Taman Ujung, located at the coast of Tumbu village. This was a resting place for the King of Karangasem, known as "The Water Palace", built around 1919. The spectacular views from the pavilion on top of the hill are worth the climb. Next, on your way to Amed you can enjoy the fantastic views along the coast. Up to the North, you will see the traditional process of sea salt making in Amed. The sea salt making season starts from July-November. Visiting Tirtagangga will be the last visit of your cultural experience. Built in 1948 by the last King of Karangasem. Tirtagangga is surrounded by a landscape of terraced rice fields, and as the name implies is the source of holy water for the many religious ceremonies of East Bali.

Community Culture & Temple 7 hours USD 50.00

Our Leisure Concierge will guide you to local village events and ceremonies where you can participate in learning Hindu temple ceremony protocol, the Balinese interpretation of Hinduism in regards to ceremony ritual and the history of passing culture on through the children. Visit Tenganan, a pre-Hindu village, where you will see their unique way of life. Then we will take you to the Royal Palace in Amlapura, Puri Agung. You will find old photographs of the royal family, the royal bedroom and costumes. Your cultural experience ends with a visit to Pura Besakih the mother temple of Bali. It is most enjoyable during one of the frequent festivals, when hundred of Hinduism devotees come to pray, gorgeously adorned with beautifully arranged offerings.

*Ceremony Events schedule will be according to the Balinese calendar and local priests. Due to availability, above schedule can be reviewed. Please see our Leisure Concierge at the Front Desk.

A half day trip to Bangli regency in the middle of Bali. In this trip, our leisure concierge will take you to the Balinese traditional village, Panglipuran through a bamboo forest to see the traditional Balinese compound and their village life. Followed by visiting Kehen Temple in the north of Bangli. Kehen temple is one of the largest temples in Bali and is a stirring example of the skill of the stone-carvers of the region. Founded in the 11th century, Kehen Temple has three courtyards that are each entered through towering, carved gateways.

This trip is also able to be arranged as an additional trip on the way to our sister property in East Bali, Alila Manggis.

Snorkeling

Snorkels, masks and fins are available for hourly or daily hire, for children as well. Alila Manggis has a Jukung that can take you straight from the beach subject to beach conditions in front of the hotel to the Blue Lagoon, a small but colourful reef just off the coastline. Fishing Like the Balinese

Always wanted to fish like all Balinese fisherman do? Take this opportunity and leave in the early morning fishing with our Alila Jukung. Our kitchen team will be pleased to cook a tasty seafood platter for lunch or dinner from your "catch of the day". Starts: 7.30am

Traditional Deep Water Fishing

Enjoy the thrill of the catch! Jump aboard our traditional Jukung and head out to the deep water fishing area around the Nusa Penida Strait – a playground for angling small tuna fish, red snappers, jackfish and many other deep water creatures. If you prefer bottom fishing, snappers, blue coral fish and scribbled filefish are teeming under the sea. You can also bring along snorkelling gear to enjoy some deep sea swimming.

White Water Rafting at Telaga Waja

USD 68.00 nett

The spirit of adventure begins on the hilly sites of sacred Mt. Agung. Here the untouched forest and emerald green paddy fields water into the valley that channels the Telaga Waja River into a gushing river heading for the coast. It is a river to be respected; yet it also offers the perfect playground for this exhilarating sport. The torrent twists and turns like an angry white snake struggling for the ocean yet the internationally trained guides negotiate the rapids with great skill. During the trip you will travel 14km along the river and descend over 200m down the mountainside – furious and fun! Duration: 8.45am to 4.00pm This is a level 4 water rapid course.

*Includes: air-conditioned returned transfers, refreshments & snacks, buffet lunch, shower/changing room & toilet facilities, world-class safety equipment, and USD100,000 insurance coverage. Discover the magnificent places of Bali by mountain bike. Jump on your bike, visit the local compounds and take a stop wherever you like to admire the beautiful views...

Antiga – Andakasa (12km)

1 hour + 15 mins car transfer

Our Leisure Concierge will bring you to Antiga by hotel's car, where you will start your cycling adventure. You will pass the quiet roads that will lead you to breathtaking views over the rice terraces and beautiful nature. A relaxed trip that provides you the time to enjoy the spectacular sceneries along the way.

Manggis – Selumbung (10km)

1 hours

Biking through Manggis village to Selumbung is a gentle cycling trip suitable for beginners and experienced cyclist alike, from 12 yrs to 65 yrs old of age. There are several steep inclines along the way. Our recommendation is to pick up this route half way at Selumbung village and return on the same route to the hotel.

Sengkidu Village (6km) 45 mins
This short route will take you off the beaten track (dirt roads) and allows you to experience typical daily life of Balinese. The trek ends with some options:

- Visit the traditional village of Tenganan, famous for double ikat weaving and basket making.
- Visit Candi Dasa, for shopping or head straight back to the hotel.

Gumung adventure bike USD 30.00
Leave the beaten track well and truly behind as you fully immerse yourself in the rugged nature of Bali. Cycle through the forest and discover Bali's wild and indigenous flora. Your winding, downhill trek passes a spectacular view of rice terraces at Sanghyang Ambu village and the colourful fishing vessels moored at Bugbug village.

Cycling starts at 8.00 am from the lobby hotel. Be aware of the sun and bring your sun block. Not recommended for children under the age of 12 years. Please book one day in advance with our Leisure Concierge. Prices are per person and subject to 11% tax and 10% service. A minimum of 2 persons is required to enjoy these experiences except bicycling. Single supplement upon application.

Alila Adventure Trekking
East Bali is renowned for its spectacular physical beauty and the traditional lifestyle of its people. One of the best ways to discover this is by walking through the countryside and observing first-hand the life of the local families as they go about their daily activities. We have three walking/trekking routes that we recommend. Please note that difficulty grades and all trekking experiences are at own risk.

Young Explorer Morning Walk 2 and a half hours + 10 mins car transfer USD 20.00
A fun and sporty way for your young ones to explore East Bali! This beginner level trek is suitable for children aged from 6 to 12 years old. Let them discover the area's tropical natural while learning about the local customs, rice fields and the famous subak (water irrigation) system. The morning exercise ends in our organic garden where the children can relax, swap tales and enjoy some refreshments.

Gumung – Tenganan trek 2 hours + 20 mins car transfer USD 50.00
Culture comes alive in this eye-opening trek. Witness how local villages live and work in harmony with the environment to sustain their way of life and traditions. Start at Gumung village, where you visit the micro hydro plant and learn about how the fast flowing streams and rivers surrounding the area are transformed into electricity that powers the rice mill, which in turn enables local Tenganan rice to be husked. Then walk off the beaten track to Tenganan, a traditional Balinese village steeped in history and tradition. Your guide points out vegetation and medicinal plants along the way, explaining their use in Balinese daily life. When you arrive at Tenganan, take a rest at its sacred temple under the dense canopy of a giant Banyan tree. Here, enjoy a fascinating introduction to the intricate art of weaving, the natural dyeing process and ikat basket-making-local skills that have survived unchanged for centuries. Back at hotel, you also learn about the delicate technique of lontar writing, or writing on palm leaves. (Beginner to medium level trek)

Hillside Adventure Trek 2 and a half hours + 20 mins car transfer USD 30.00
Prepare to be awed by the spectacular natural beauty of East Bali. You set off from the hillside village of Gumung, where the panoramic view is breathtaking, sweeping from majestic Mount Agung to the sea. As you go downhill, you find palm sugar trees thriving in their natural environment, not far from Bali's most exotic fruits such as durian and white mango. (Beginner to medium level trek)

Kastala to Tenganan 2 hours + 20 mins car transfer USD 25.00
This trek is really off the beaten track and crosses through numerous rice terraces and small farms allowing you to truly appreciate the native landscape of Bali. The trek also takes you up and over a number of hills that offer great views to the sea, before finishing at the fascinating Bali Age village of Tenganan, famous for its double ikat weaving and unique basket making.

Trekking starts at 8.00 am from the lobby hotel. Be aware of the sun and bring your sun block. Not recommended for children under the age of 12 years. Please book one day in advance with our Leisure Concierge. Prices are per person and subject to 11% tax and 10% service. A minimum of 2 persons is required to enjoy these experiences. Single supplement upon application.

Holy Trek to Heaven 2 and a half hours + 1 hour car transfer USD 50.00
An unforgettable spiritual trek to visit a holy hill, Lempuyang. After 1 hour drive from the hotel with our leisure concierge, you will start your trek from Jumenang where you can see mount Agung and Lombok island. Have a blessing at a small temple before stepping into the holy mountain and continue the trek through pandang forest where you will see many kinds of tropical botanicals and animals. Once you have reached the top of Lempuyang hill, rest to enjoy the view and our concierge will assist you to dress in full traditional Balinese sarong in preparation to visit this special temple, Lempuyang Luhur, and meet the local priest for a Hindu blessing. After the blessing our leisure concierge will describe the unique story of holy water in the holy bamboo in the temple as you climb the many steps down again, passing other Balinese temple visitors along the way.

Mount Agung Trek 7 hours + 2 hours car transfer USD 100.00
For the truly adventurous, perhaps you would like to consider a grueling 7-hours climb up the slopes of Mount Agung - reaching the top just in time for the spectacular sunrise. Depart from the hotel at 2.00 am to ensure you reach the top by 7.00 am. Two days notice is required.

Grand Panoramic Trek 3 hours + 2 hours car transfer USD 65.00
Embark on an inspiring trek that will leave you awed and humbled by Bali's natural beauty. Follow in our leisure concierge's footsteps as the island's hidden glories are unveiled. Your journey starts at Sidemen, a small village that boasts magnificent unending views of rice paddies. Cross the rice paddies and jump over the clear irrigation water as you hike up to the sacred and secluded Hindu temple located on top of Sangkan mountain. Be rewarded with a picture-postcard view of the valley below. After all this exercise, relax at beautiful private villa at Ogang village and savour Balinese specialities served by local chefs. (Medium to advance level trek)

Note: This trek is recommended for those who are in good physical condition and are seeking a challenge. You must also possess suitable attire – hiking boots (or good trainers), warm clothing as it is rather chilly once you get close to the summit.

Sunrise at Mount Batur 4 hours + 3 hour car transfer USD 100.00
Catch the first light of day from the top of the active volcano, Mount Batur. You deoart from the hotel at 02.30 am. The early start is worth it as you trek your way up and arrive at the summit of the mountain at 06.30 am, in time to savour a volcanic steamed breakfast while watching the sun rising from the east. Then continue your half-day tour of the crater and soak your hard-worked muscles in a natural hot spring. Before heading back to the hotel, enjoy lunch in Penelokan village with a view of the mountain in full daylight. (Medium to advanced level trek).

Trekking starts at 8.00 am from the lobby hotel. Be aware of the sun and bring your sun block. Not recommended for children under the age of 12 years. Please book one day in advance with our Leisure Concierge. Prices are per person and subject to 11% tax and 10% service. A minimum of 2 persons is required to enjoy these experiences. Explore the island by Harley Davidson

Take a blast through the past in a 1975 Volkswagen Safari as you discover the many faces of Bali unchanged by modernity. The choice of tours includes:

- The Classical Tour USD 149.00
Via Tabanan regency, you head to Tanah Lot or the land in the middle of the sea, one of Bali's holiest sites. Continue to Pura Luhur Temple at Batu Karu mountain. Enjoy the scenery of rice terraces around Jati Luwih. After a relaxing lunch, visit a sea of fruits, flowers and spices at Candi Kuning traditional market before the last stop at Ulun Danu temple at Bratan Lake.
- Hidden Bali USD 149.00
Uncover the hidden gems of Bali. Start with the 17th century royal Temple of Pura Taman Ayun. Traveling along country roads, you pass by picturesque rice fields, traditional Balinese markets and the magnificent Ayung River.

From there, stretch your legs with a pleasant twenty-minute walk to an exotic coffee and clove plantation, and end with marvellous views of volcano lakes Tamblingan and Buyan.

Tulamben is a relatively easy dive with the USAT Liberty Shipwreck being one of the most famous and interesting dive sites in Bali. It has been said that this dive has endless surprises with its' 120meter shipwreck at one end, a dramatic drop-off reef at the other and rich sand slopes and a bank reef in between.

Blue Lagoon

Blue Lagoon is a sloping reef shifting to sand at 20 meters. Only 15 minutes from the beachfront of Alila Manggis, you can swim to it from the beach at Padang Bai. This rocky unassuming stretch of reef is perfect for divers or photographers interested in unusual marine life as curious animals are known to frolic these waters such as Nudibranchs and other Gastropods, strange walking Scorpion fish, flying Gurnards, Stargazers, Pipefish and Turtle, Napoleon wrasse, Tuna, white tip shark and catsharks that are mainly seen at night.

Nusa Penida & Nusa Lembongan

These sites can be difficult, particularly after a full and new moon where currents are at their strongest, a dive most definitely for the experienced only.

Introduction to Balinese Cooking 6 hours USD 85.00

After an early morning breakfast with Alila Manggis Chefs, visit the morning market at Klungkung and experience the amazing sights, sounds and aromas of one of the busiest village markets in East Bali.
