#### **OUR GREEN AND ECO- FRIENDLY INITIATIVE**

The water issue and our green footprint.....

Every Capetonian has been fully pre-occupied with day zero, over the past few months, when the taps are due to run dry in the city of Cape Town. Glen Avon has catered for this event way in advance and we have been using underground water to flush our toilets, fill our swimming pools and water our gardens, for the past 20 years. In order to assist the drought crisis, we have closed one of our two swimming pools and we use this water to keep our other pool topped up and we have cut our daily water usage by sixty percent on our daily washing of linen and towels, thanks to the understanding of our wonderful guests. The plugs have been removed from the baths to encourage showering and we have had a fully functional filtration plant installed, so as all our water is filtered to the highest drinking standard. Hopefully we should not be affected, should day zero arise. Glen Avon has the most up to date Miele washing, drying and ironing machines, all managed 'in house' and we are adding to our photo voltaic, solar, backup batteries and heat pumps yearly, to assist with our electrical usage. This is a long term project and is added to each year until we reach our projected usage target. Together with all our other projects, our green footprint increases yearly. All our bathroom products are made locally and are eco friendly, as well as some of our cleaning materials. Glen Avon does not see any reason for our water supply to run dry and our guests will continue to have the luxury of their water'on tap' and filtered, as it has been in the past.

We re-cycle as much as possible, and all our Vegetable matter is used for our own composting, and our organic worm farms produce "worm tea" fertilizer for the gardens.

### SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

'We are involved in the SOIL FOR LIFE' NGO Project and also support the "ORIGINAL T-BAG DESIGN", which manages to keep around 14 people from the Hout Bay Township area, fully employed. All our staff are involved in saving all the used teabags

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in the hotel and bedrooms, which they dry and send to the little factory, where they are emptied for composting and the bags are painted and used in making all sorts of articles for sale. They have a shop in Hout Bay and the Waterfront and are more than happy to welcome guests to see their work in progress.

The 'Soil for Life' project reaches out into the poorer community to teach them how to grow vegetables, firstly building up the soil and on tiny patches, growing enough food to feed their families and selling off the balance. We donate monetarily to this worthy cause yearly.

All our towels and linen are donated to other worthy causes yearly.

### **DIRECTIONS (from Airport)**



Take the N2 Highway towards Cape Town (About 11km) Follow the Kirstenbosch Gardens signs and take the M3 south offramp towards Kiestenbosch.

After about 10 km, take the Kendal Road (Exit 15) and turn right onto Kendal Road. At the intersection turn left onto Spaanschemat River Road(M42 to Tokai) Continue through traffic Lights and take the second turning to the left onto STRAWBERRY LANE. Turn into the first turning to the left (Glen Avon Close) and follow the road around until you arrive at the gate.

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
