


The location

On the North-East coast of Mauritius, in Poste Lafayette, a region reputed for its calm, its lush vegetation, coves with preserved beaches, lined up with volcanic stones. A 35-minute drive away from the capital city, Port-Louis as well as from seaside resort Grand-Baie. 30 minutes away from l'île aux Cerfs and the Pamplemousses Botanical Garden, 15 minutes away from the better known beaches and four golf facilities, including that of Belle-Mare, La Maison d'Été is at five minutes from the best kitesurf sites and only one hour away from the airport.

It's a 14-room family establishment which combines the charm and privacy of accomodations in a family home with the services found in a hotel.

The site spreads over more that 4,000 m², with two buildings: a Mauritian family villa with five "Océan" rooms, independent from one another and yet linkable if required; a smaller 8-"Mer" room complex, with terraces.











Put up near the garden, towards La Maison d'Été's entrance, the restaurant can accomodate 65 guests. The interior restaurant can cater for 25 guests.

From the best world vineyards, the wines on our list have been carefully chosen, in harmony with the various tastes on offer.

The lounge bar offers a stunning cocktail list and a variety of Mauritian tapas for the Happy Hours.

Enjoy the billiards room after dinner, whîle sipping an aged rhum or an old armagnac.

The Restaurant

This is the must-go place for gourmets on the coast!

Planned for an in-depth perspective, set under a Traveller's Palm roof, with wicker and precious wood furniture, the atmosphere is spontaneously warm and friendly. Mauritian chef Ravin Dhauro, 37, has been at the stoves for many years. His dishes are inspired by Mauritian cuisine and made up of fresh sea food as well as produces of the land:

- Tuna carpaccio with lime peel and candied ginger,
- Vanilla flavoured sea bream tartare with pink pepper,
- Octopus salad with passion fruit dressing served with palm tree hearts...

and over the weekend, the traditional "Mauritian Sunday" lunch, served as a buffet.

> YOU'll FLY. vou'll take off at Anse-la-Raie, under Hans' expert eye, or in Palmar with Maud and Julien...
