

Little Mombo Camp
Premier Wilderness Camp

LOCATION

- Northern Botswana
- Central Okavango Delta
- On Mombo Island on the northern tip of Chief's Island
- Moremi Game Reserve, northern area

SEASONS / CHILD POLICY

Festive Season: 16 December 2010 to 06 January 2011 & 20 December 2011 to 06 January 2012

Low Season: 07 January 2011 to 31 March 2011

Shoulder Season: 01 April 2011 to 14 June 2011 & 01 November 2011 to 19 December 2011

High season: 15 June 2011 to 31 October 2011

Children of 6 years and older are accommodated however private activities need to be booked and paid for.

ACCOMMODATION

Number of tents:

- Three luxurious guest tents with 2 x $\frac{3}{4}$ twin beds in each tent.
- Custom-made linen enables twin beds to be converted into a king sized bed on request in all tents.
- One twin guide tent that is shared with Mombo Main Camp – it is the same standard as a guest tent but much smaller in size.

This camp can accommodate six guests plus tour leader.

Room details:

- Luxury tents on raised decks overlooking the surrounding game filled plains
- En-suite bathrooms with indoor as well as outdoor shower
- Separate flush toilet
- Entrance to tent has a door not zip
- Veranda in front of tent
- Fan
- Mosquito net
- Soaps, shampoos and insect repellents are supplied in each tent
- Sala at each tent
- Safe in each tent
- Hairdryer on request

CAMP DESCRIPTION

- Dining room is under thatch raised on deck
- Plunge pool
- Gym area
- Menu of massage treatments (at an additional cost) - conducted in the privacy of the guest's tent
- Curio shop shared with Mombo main camp
- Kgotla (boma) for dining under the stars
- Private lounge for smaller groups, private dinners or honeymooner's dinners (shared with Mombo main camp)
- Private dinners on decks or in private lounge
- Picnics on drive offered allowing for all day excursions
- Joined by raised deck to Mombo main camp
- Deep within Moremi Game Reserve, beneath huge trees on the edge of a scenic floodplain

- Walkways connect the guest tents to the main areas
- Slide projector available

GAME VIEWING

Renowned as one of the best game areas in Africa. A predator haven with frequent excellent sightings of Lion and Leopard. Wild Dog can be seen and inter-predator interaction is a feature. Plains game is prolific – Zebra, Wildebeest, Buffalo, Giraffe and all the Delta Antelopes are present in numbers. Year round birding is superb.

ACTIVITIES

Type – 100% Game Drives, 0% Water Activities (although guests do see water)

- Game drives via 1 x 10 seater open Land Rover for six guests, allowing all guests an outside seat.
- Reference books available in each guest tent for use on drives. Binoculars and Peaceful Sleep insect repellent are available in a centre console on each row of seats - the middle consoles can be swapped for seats, i.e. if a row of 3 seats are needed rather than a row of 2 seats plus a consol.
- The camp does have a supply of bean bags for guests to use to steady their camera while on a game activity.
- Game drives on Chief's Island and surrounding area
- Best game viewing in Botswana
- Private vehicle on request (maximum five vehicles in the concession with three primarily being used at Mombo main camp, one at Little Mombo and one available for private vehicle booking).
- Hippo hide located 20 minutes from camp which can be used for bush brunches.

SUGGESTED DAILY ACTIVITY SCHEDULE

The Premier camps are very flexible with meal times/venues and activity times and thus this is an indication only.

Summer/winter

05h00/06h00 - Wake up call. Light continental breakfast consisting of cereals, tea/coffee/juices and pastries to be served in the dining area.

06h00/07h00 - Depart on morning activity, returning to camp.

10h30/11h00 - Brunch will be served, this will consist of a selection of breakfast and lunch dishes.

From now until afternoon tea, guests will be at leisure.

15h20/15h00 - Afternoon tea will be served – this will consist of a selection of sweet and savoury snacks.

16h00/15h30 - Depart on afternoon game viewing activity.

Sunset - Return to camp (dependant on park rules).

20h00/19h30 - Pre-dinner drinks and snacks will be served at the pub.

20h30/20h00 - Three course dinner – all courses are served at the table except on Mondays (traditional night) when the starter and dessert are served whilst the main course is buffet style.

21h30/21h00 - Coffee and liqueurs will be served at the camp fire. Cigars available.

ELECTRICITY & WATER

- Camp has 220v generator powered electricity run in kitchen and main areas. Silent generator runs 24 hours per day.
- 220v generator power is used for lighting and fans in each guest tent 24hrs/day.
- 220v plugs and multi-national adaptor available in each tent for guests to charge batteries and for the use of sleep apnoea machines. Hence bring spare battery and charging unit.
- Generator heated/powerd geysers.

DRINKS POLICY

All drinks are included in the nightly tariff, with the exception of premium wines & champagne, premium liqueurs & spirits.

LAUNDRY POLICY

Laundry is done on a daily basis and inclusive in the nightly tariff.

EXTRA PAYMENT

Curios, imported drinks and tips/gratuities can be billed to the tent number and settled on check out. Payment can be effected by cash (US\$), travellers' cheques or the following credit cards: Visa or MasterCard.

FLYING TIMES

to/from Maun 30 minutes

to/from Kasane 1 hr 20 minutes

Kasane to Victoria Falls 20 minutes but allow additional time for customs and immigration.

AIRSTRIP DETAILS

Mombo airstrip located 15 minutes' drive from camp

Licensed for heavier aircraft up to 5700kg MAUW (maximum all up weight), can take King Airs provided that they have flotation gear.

(Mombo Main Camp is five minutes away from Little Mombo).
